GOLF COURSE RULES - Committee Chair: Addie Egan, 402-802-2070, adrienne@absoluteclean.biz

- 1. All members must register themselves and each guest for partial and/or full rounds of golf. If you have no guest, please XXX out the "guest columns" opposite your signature to prevent someone else's quest from being listed opposite your name and charged to your account. Register at the bulletin board on the west wall of the clubhouse by the #1 tee.
- 2. Guest fees are posted at the Clubhouse patio and on the Fee Schedule in the green handbook. Guests must play with a member unless prior permission has been obtained for an exception to the rule.
- 3. Players under 14 may use the golf course and putting green if accompanied by a member. However, young adults under 14 may petition the golf chairman for a waiver of the adult requirement and play unaccompanied if the chair and his or her committee are satisfied that the applicant has sufficient skill and maturity to play without an adult. Golfers under 14 years of age may be asked to leave the course if they are not accompanied by an adult, or have a waiver.
- 4. Any resident hosting groups of more than 8 players must make advance arrangements with the golf chair, Addie Egan at 402-802-2070.
- 5. Members of golf leagues authorized by the Board are permitted to golf for the daily fee of \$8 outside of league play. They are not allowed to bring guests.
- 6. Each group must display a valid and current players tag. Individuals or groups not displaying a tag may be challenged by another member or the course marshal.
- 7. Golfers must wear a shirt and shoes at all times. Bare feet are exposed to injury and chemicals. No shoes with metal spikes may be worn.
- 8. Golf etiquette shall prevail at all times. Players should replace divots on the tees, and repair ball marks on all greens.
- 9. Members and guests are expected to help keep the course clean and in good condition by using litter baskets and observing golf etiquette.
- 10. Owners are responsible for payment of renters' golf fees.
- 11. Golfers are expected to notify the owner and compensate for any damage to personal property (especially windows) surrounding the course.
- 12. No vehicles of any kind are allowed on the golf course.
- 13. No dogs are allowed on the course, either accompanied by golfers or being exercised. Animal Control will be asked to serve citations to owners of unleashed dogs in accordance with the Lincoln City Ordinance.
- 14. The Course is closed when:
 - a. Lighting occurs.
 - b. Flags are removed from greens and signs are posted on 1, 3 and 8.
 - c. There is frost.

The fee schedule for the golf course for member's guest is \$5. For nonresident family it is \$275, nonresident individual is \$220. For nonresident youths (14 and under) it is \$55.00.
